DEEPER DISCUSSION

- 1. Our advent theme this past Sunday was peace. What does the word peace mean to you?
- 2. What do you think robs you of peace? Why?
- 3. What could you do to maintain a more peaceful heart?
- 4. In our passage this week the situation appeared hopeless and bleak. Where in your life have you felt like the situation was impossible? How did God move in that situation?
- 5. The new king that God is raising up from the stump of Jesse will enjoy a reign characterized by righteousness. How does Isaiah describe this reign? (v.2-5)
- 6. Why is a godly leader (king, president, manager, coach, pastor, etc.) such a blessing to a people?
- 7. As God fulfilled this prophecy, what kind of peace did Jesus bring at his first Advent? And what kind of peace will Jesus bring at his second coming?
