REFLECTION QUESTIONS

DEEPER DISCUSSION

- 1. Paul never let his current circumstances distract him from fulfilling the mission to which God called him. How does this encourage you to press on in the midst of difficult circumstances?
- 2. Do you recall moments in your life where you have been "ashamed" of Christ in some way? If so, when? Why?
- 3. Paul tells Timothy that he does not need to be ashamed because of the "power of God". What other passages of Scripture do we see the power of God on display in the lives of believers?
- 4. What can help us during moments of fear, shame, embarrassment, etc?
- 5. God orchestrates interactions and conversations for a reason and you will have opportunities this week to share your faith. How do we know when we should share our faith? How can we take advantage of every Gospel opportunity?
