REFLECTION QUESTIONS

Read the passage (II Timothy 3:1-9) and answer the following questions:

- 1. What stands out most and why?
- 2. What does the passage reveal to us about God?
- 3. What does the passage reveal to us about ourselves?
- 4. What are the immediate application points?

DEEPER DISCUSSION

- 1. Paul is very clear with Timothy that the context of his ministry will be a culture that is difficult. Why is that explanation helpful to us? Why do you think we are often so surprised by trials and difficulty?
- 2. Where have you seen the sins of vv2-5 in our current culture? Where have you seen them in your own heart?
- 3. We mentioned on Sunday that these difficult times have a way of creeping into the church as well. What can we do to protect and guard our hearts?
- 4. What is Timothy to do with these people (v.5)? Does that sound like a "Christian" response? Why or why not?
- 5. What encouragement does Paul give to Timothy and the Ephesian church when it comes to these false teachers (v.9)?
- 6. Read Psalm 37:1-7. What can we do when it seems like the wicked and evil are prospering? How are we to handle that tension?
