Read the passage (Matthew 13:1-23) and answer the following questions:

- 1. What stands out most and why?
- 2. What does the passage reveal to us about God?
- 3. What does the passage reveal to us about ourselves?
- 4. What are the immediate application points?

## **DEEPER DISCUSSION**

- 1. Jesus often teaches through the use of parables. Why does he use that method? (v.10-13)
- 2. How was this a fulfillment of Isaiah 6:9-10?
- 3. What does it mean to see and not "see?" Or to hear and not "hear?"
- 4. Why were the disciples able to understand Jesus' teaching? What made the difference for them?
- 5. Share with the group your own experience of coming to faith in Jesus. Did you find yourself struggling to understand the gospel?
- 6. Discuss the different types of soil and what they represent. What is to blame for a lack of fruit in their lives?
- 7. On Sunday we talked about the role of the sower. He/she is to be faithful to scatter seeds regardless of the reception. How can you be more engaged in the work of "sowing seeds?"
